Important information:

Please read the following instructions carefully. They are for your safety and to make sure you get the most out of this unique and wonderful event.

1. The walk has a staggered start between 7.00pm and 7.30pm and can take between 1hr 30 mins and 3 hrs to complete. It's not a race, so please take your time and enjoy the lights and attractions.
2. The registration point will be by the tram station at Bispham and all walkers must check in with us before the walk starts please. The finishing point is at Sharples Hall, where refreshments will be provided. Please check in upon completion of the walk.
3. Parking is available at either end of the walk on side streets. Park at the finish point (near Sharples Hall) and get a tram from Starr Gate to our starting point at Bispham or park near the start and get the return tram at the end of the walk.
4. All walkers take part in the Walk the Lights at their own risk and the Rosemere Cancer Foundation will not be responsible for any loss, sickness or injury that might occur as a result of taking part. Please be sensible with footwear and dress accordingly to our autumnal weather, ideally with a warm waterproof jacket.
5. If you take photos please let us have them for our website and newsletter!
6. **MOST IMPORTANT** - this event is weather dependent and may be cancelled at short notice. It is your responsibility to check that the walk has not been postponed due to bad weather and you can do this by:

 - Calling the Rosemere office on 01772 522913 - if the walk is cancelled a message will be left on the answerphone
 - Checking Rosemere's Facebook and Twitter pages which will be updated regularly
